Unit 4	<p>Introduction to poetry (4 lessons per fortnight): Students will study the poetic form and explore different types of poetry.</p> <p>Language focus (2 lessons per fortnight): Spoken language</p> <p>Library (2 lessons per fortnight): Year 7 reading programme</p>
