

Dear Parents / Carers

RE: Important information and dates

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19):

I am writing to reassure you that the school continues to follow the Government advice to ensure the health of our whole community, including pupils and staff. The advice being given to schools is that there is no need for school closure at the moment.

We are monitoring hygiene practices and are going to ensure that from Monday 16th March areas in the school which are regularly touched (such as door handles, light switches, desks and table tops) are thoroughly cleaned. In addition to this we plan to have a deeper clean of the school on Friday 3rd April should we remain open until then as per the current Government guidelines.

We are strongly advising all parents to ensure their child has their own anti-bacterial gel in school, and that they ensure their child knows how to use it safely. Please also provide a packet of tissues so that they can sneeze and cough into this and bin it as advised. Please encourage your child to regularly wash their hands throughout the day. In addition to this can you please ensure your child is not sharing their water bottle and or food with other students.

There are currently no confirmed cases of coronavirus in this school.

Until we are told by the Government, our school will remain open and, as far as possible function normally. I receive an e-mail from the Department of Education on a daily basis with the latest advice for Headteachers and I will continue to follow this to the letter. It is for the Government to advise schools on whether they should close in response to this outbreak or not.

In the event that we are forced to close the school due to Government action, could you please ensure that your child has the correct log in details for all learning platforms. Instructions and independent work will be set on Google Classroom, for example, in the event of closure.
