Food & drink

- You will need to bring water in bottles with your name on as the fountains have been replaced by a row of sinks for hand washing.
- If you arrive at 8.35am you will have your 'lunch' at 11.00am which will be grab and go from your designated area.
- If you arrive at 9.45am you will have your lunch at 1.30am which will also be grab and go.

Personal hygiene

- On arrival to school please wash and dry your hands thoroughly.
- Ensure you wash/sanitise your hands before eating anything – there are many new sanitising stations around school.
- To help keep us all safe carry your own sanitiser too and use it regularly.
- Carry tissues and practice the ‘catch it, bin it, kill it regime’

Travel

- Where possible walk to school.
- If arriving on public transport you will need to wear a mask if you are over 11 years old.
- You are permitted to wear a mask in school if you wish but you will need to remove it if a member of staff asks you for identification purposes.

Equipment

- To keep you safe you need to bring your own equipment to school each day this should include pens black and green, pencils, ruler, eraser, calculator and your planner.
- You will be give a white board pen to use with the board on your planner as we cannot share boards and pens between groups

School is cashless

- All payments must now be done through our payment system 'wisepay'
- Your canteen cards must be topped up this way and any books/equipment you need to buy must be paid for via wisepay too.

PE

- Must come to school in PE kit as no changing room use
- Bring named water bottles as no fountains
- Cannot share equipment (balls, bibs, bats, etc.)
- Come straight down to hall after break time (all lessons are period 3 and 4)
- Must give valuables to teacher to lock in PE office
- Try to maintain social distance where applicable
- Must wash hands before and after PE lessons

Medical needs

- We cannot send you to the office for minor medical issues such as plasters/ice packs or other items.
- If you have medicine in school that you have to take you will be allocated a time to do this to preserve the year group bubbles
- Students with medical passes will be allowed to visit the office

Keeping everybody safe

- You will work within your year group 'bubble' this may mean some lessons have to be delivered in a different way.
- You must bring all your own equipment – we cannot lend you items or let you share with others.
- We cannot let you get out of your seat during a lesson.
- We cannot let you leave the room during the lesson.
- You need to face the front of the room at all times and avoid turning around.
- Staff need to stay 2m away from you so may not be able to help you in the normal way.
- You need to support the learning process for everyone by working hard and staying on task.

Further disruption may result in parents having to collect you to take you home

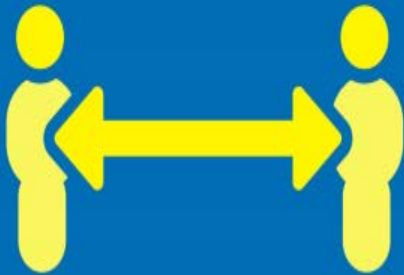
Keeping everybody safe

CATCH IT
