The SLT and the Governors have reviewed our start of term and daily operations in our 'year group bubble' system and will continue to do so to inform future practice. The focus of the new way of working is to keep everyone safe and prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus to avoid partial or complete closure of the school for students and staff.

Further Update Details for Year 11

All students have had all the details and systems explained to them and we need their continued support as we move forward into the coming weeks.

Details

Face masks	Could all students please ensure they are wearing face masks in the corridors and when they line up for lunch. Students must have a face mask for travelling on public transport and a different one for in school. Many thanks for your support in this. Students must be wearing face masks when they are standing outside the school waiting to come in. However, we would ask students not to congregate by the gate if they arrive too early. Please try to ensure students arrive at the time the gates open for their arrival time. We must be considerate to our neighbours and community. Many thanks for your support in this.
Lunch	We are hoping that 'LUNCHTIME' will be providing hot takeaway food from next week. We will transition into sitting down in the canteen once students have got used to certain routines. Also, we are in discussion with them over the choice of menu for the next few weeks as we have not been satisfied with the service since coming back. We appreciate the difficulties they may be experiencing but we want to work with them to improve the service during this difficult time.
CHROME BOOK order	We are still awaiting the arrival of the Chrome Books – once they have arrived we will inform parents / carers who then may wish to purchase one. I am guessing that due to the high demand from all schools nationally and internationally that this is the reason for the long delay in getting our order.

Uniform	On the whole we have been mega impressed with the school uniform, however, some students need to now ensure they are in full school uniform – please refer to the student planner for the details. It is a shame that a very small minority of students, despite being in Yr11, cannot support our expectations concerning this. A good attitude is linked to successful outcomes. Homelearning	The focus on our return has been on getting students back into routines and we should now turn our focus to doing more independent homelearning.
